Carolyn Osborn Viuhkola – descended from Robert and Elizabeth Ann Hussey Stewart (two daughters married Osborn boys)

Betty I. (Beedles) Ralph – great-granddaughter of William Ellsworth Stewart

The earliest trace of my Stewart line is of my sixth great-grandfather, William Stewart, born in Edinburgh, Scotland. William is reported to be the son of James and?? Reid Stewart. Many thanks to my fifth cousin, Betty Beedles Ralph, for the breakthrough and volumes of information she provided me on this line. Much of the information provided came from Alverta Brown Martin's book, "Findley Family History".¹ Alverta Brown describes the circumstances of William's immigration to the states and his eventual marriage to Mary Orr in Donegal Springs, PA prior to his November 1824 death in Washington County, Virginia.

The Coffel line is in its infancy of my research. Although the name itself is not a common one – it has not been very easy finding the data. I have included much of what I found in hopes of eventually making a connection to my own line. At this point, the only information I know for sure is that Stewart ancestor, Joseph Franklin Stewart (1818 – 1897) married Rebecca Coffel in 1844 Des Moines County, Iowa. I have located Rebecca's mother, Elizabeth², in 1850 Monroe County, Iowa, but that is the first and last record I have on her parents.

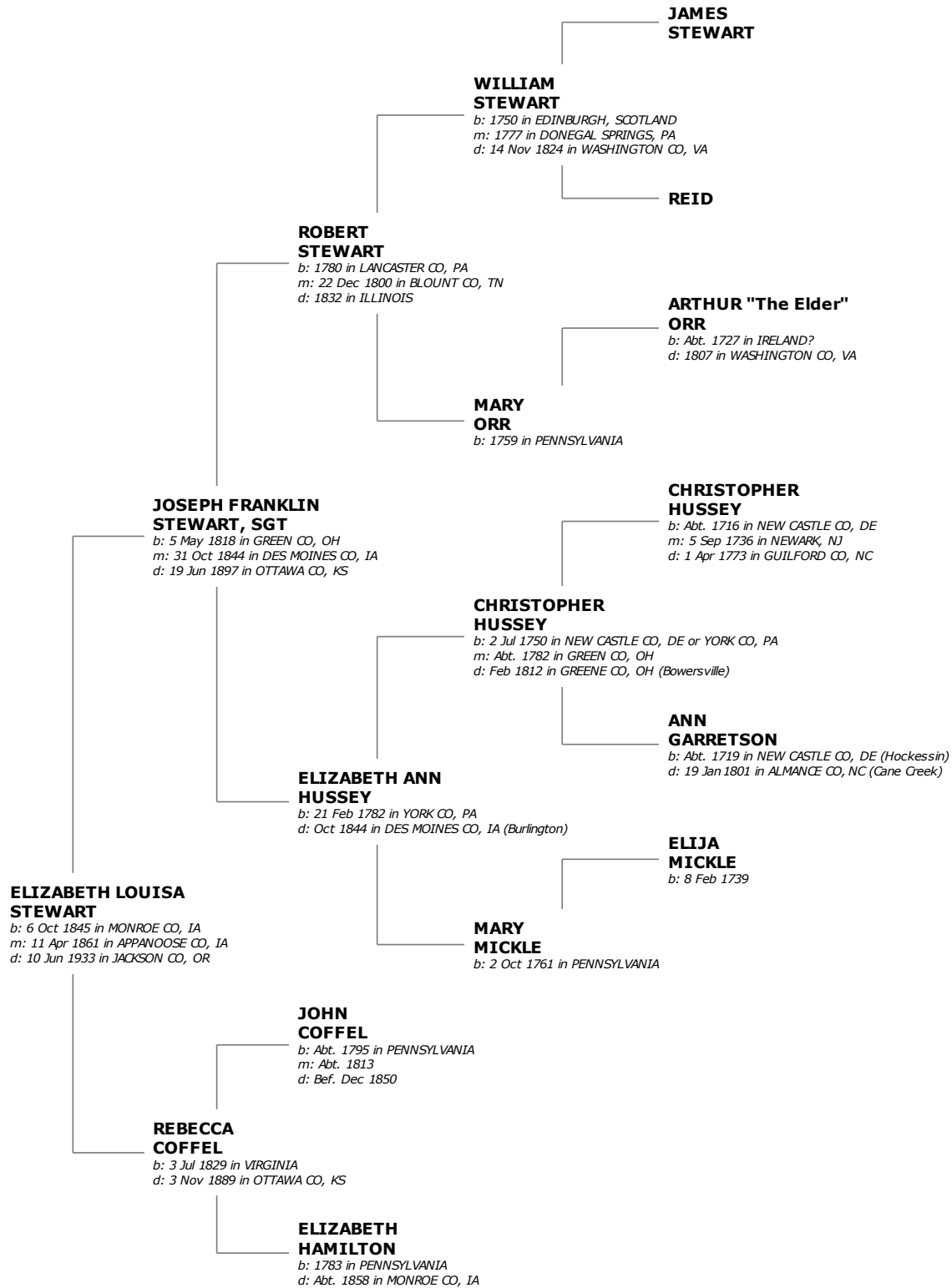

In April 1861, Elizabeth Louisa Stewart, my third great-grandmother and daughter of Joseph and Rebecca Stewart, married John Davis in Appanoose County. Around 1880, the Joseph F. Stewart family moved to Ottawa County, Kansas- along with the John Davis family and his parents, Edmund and Harriet Davis.

³ George Coffel likely son of John and Nancy Lefever Coffel (Mary is most likely sister to Nancy). The John Coffel family could not be located after the 1856 IA state census – based on the birth location of George they must have went to Kansas.

William Stewart (1750 – 1824)

Biography

Alverta Brown Martin “Findley Family History”

William was trained as an architectural stonemason, capable of such specialties as window and door archways. When he was 24 he was working under Simon Porteus for the company owned by his father, James Stewart, and uncle James Reid, on a Royal Command contract in either Leith or Dundee, Scotland.

One morning a privateer arrived and sent marines ashore to capture young men for service under King George's infamous "impressment of Sailors Act." William thought he was exempt since he was working on a royal contract and didn't bother to hide. He was captured and taken aboard.

The ship went on a shake-down cruise in the North Sea, then landed at Newcastle-on-Tyne to take on provisions. William was sent to get fresh water with a fisherman who was trying to locate his own son who had been captured by another privateer. They delivered the water after dark and William was able to hide under a canvas on the fisherman's boat and escape. He hid in an unoccupied stone cottage for several days until the privateer sailed. The fisherman then took him to Newcastle.

James Stewart had sent Simon Porteus to Newcastle to look for William and help him if he showed up. They met at a tavern in Newcastle. William was a marked man if he remained in the British isles, so Simon booked passage on the Georgia Packet which sailed 11 Sep 1775. When it arrived at the port of Savannah, GA, the harbour was full of privateers, so the captain slipped out of the harbour that night and sailed to New Castle, PA (now DE). William went ashore and Simon returned to Scotland.

The Continental Army captured William as he boldly looked for work. He had entered illegally, was unknown, and was a Stewart so was taken before Cpt (later Col) Hugh Pedan to be tried and hanged as a spy. Fortunately, Pedan believed William's story, put up his bond, and sent him by stage coach to Pedan's Tavern located between Lancaster and Harrisburg, PA, on the Little Chicquesaluga River. He arrived Nov or Dec 1775 and paid for his room and board working as hostler, kitchen boy, and doing odd jobs.

Lancaster authorities, representing the Continental Congress, wrote to the port authorities in Scotland. The Scottish had a full record of the abduction, were sympathetic so immediately replied telling the Lancaster authorities to release William. With the reply, James Stewart sent a letter and 50 pounds sterling, a considerable sum of money in Colonial America. William bought himself a wig, cocked hat, knee britches, silk stockings, silver buckled shoes, and a gold headed cane and proclaimed himself a Gentleman.

William did not serve in the Revolutionary War, but with idle Continental Troops and local settlers, quarried limestone and build the Donegal Springs Presbyterian Church. The church maintained a school for young people to which Arthur "The Elder" Orr of Adams Co, PA, sent his oldest daughter, Mary. She stayed at Pedan's Tavern and helped out with chores to pay her room and board.

William and Mary fell in love. Her father disapproved of the romance, but when she turned 18 in early 1777 they were married. Arthur "The Elder" Orr did not attend the wedding, so she was given away by Col Hugh Pedan. Rev Colin McFarquher (who had been William's roommate) performed the ceremony.

The couple lived in a small house in Lancaster Co, PA, until 1785 when they traveled the wilderness Road to Washington CO, VA. William used 565 pounds sterling inherited from his father's estate to purchase a sizable plantation southeast of Wolf Hills (now Abingdon), VA. William is buried in the Old Glade Springs Presbyterian Church cemetery.

William's Orr Family In-laws

Alverta Brown Martin “Our Grandfathers”

The Orr family, originally from Scotland, probably migrated to Ireland after 1607 during the period of Protestant settlement. They left Ireland for Pennsylvania, possibly as early as 1730 as part of the Scotch-Irish migration. The name of Arthur's father is not known. After his father died, his mother, Margaret, married John Brandon around 1735. The Brandons lived in Hanover township, Lancaster (now Dauphin) county, Pennsylvania.

Arthur had a claim for land on the west side of the Susquahanna River in Huntington township, York county, Pennsylvania, before 1750. He was living on the east side of the Susquahanna River, Manor township, Lancaster county, Pennsylvania, in 1758 and 1759. He moved across the river to Tyrone township, York county, Pennsylvania, with his young family by 1762. He was constable there in 1767 and 1768, a millwright, and supervisor of highways.

Arthur did not approve of his daughter Mary's marriage to William Stewart and did not attend the wedding. In 1794, however, Arthur and his son Arthur sold their farms in Adams county, Pennsylvania, and moved to Washington county, Virginia, acquiring a large plantation a short distance from Mary and William Stewart's. Lewis and Catherine Will sold Arthur Orr 402 acres on Cedar Creek for \$1,666 on 21 July 1795.

William Stewart Will

I William Stewart of Washington County in the State of Virginia do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner following towit I will that my body after death be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors, that out of the worldly estate with which it hat pleased God to bless me, my lawful debts and funeral charges be first paid and next the following legacies - To my wife Mary my plantation together with all my household and kitchen furniture all my stock of cattle, sheep, hogs, and all my books except such as is hereafter devised by her to be enjoyed during her life, and after her decease to be equally divided between my daughter Elizabeth my sons Arthur and Joseph. To my daughter Elizabeth my gray mare, a bureau, two beds of furniture, loom and tacking and two hundred dollars to be paid her after the decease of my wife out of the first money arising from the proceeds of the sale of my land. To my Son Arthur my gray horse and gray filley and the new rifle gun six new windsor chairs. To my son Joseph my iron gray mare and the spotted colt and the old rifle gun. All my farming utensils and mechanical tools I will to my sons Arthur and Joseph to be equally divided between them.

To Catharine Evans children forty dollars each and to be placed in the hands of a guardian by my executors out of the last money arising from my estate, to be paid by the guardian to them as they arrive to age of eighteen years. I direct that my executors sell my land in twelve months after the decease of my wife in the following manner one third in hand and one third in twelve months and the balance to be paid in two year, and out of the first money arising therefrom I allow my sons Arthur and Joseph to have each of them two hundred dollars -

To my son William - I allow him to enjoy the part of my plantation that he has now in possession during the life of his mother free from rent, but if he should choose to leave the aforesaid premises then my wife is to have all the profits arising therefrom.

Lastly I will that the remainder of the price of my land be equally divided amongst my children viz James Stewart, Robert Stewart, Elizabeth Stewart, Martha Ford, Mary Huzzy, Margaret Johnston, Jane Ryburn, Wm Stewart, Arthur Stewart and Joseph Stewart.

I do hereby constitute my sons Arthur and Joseph Stewart Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby disannulling and making void all former wills by me made ratifying, confirming publishing and declaring this my last Will and Testament this 17th day of March 1823.

In Witness whereof I have here unto affixed my seal and subscribed my name the day and date aforesaid.

The last Will and Testament of William Stewart deceased was exhibited in court and proved by the oath of James Orr, James Reid, and Arthur Reid the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. An on the motion of Arthur Stewart and Joseph Stewart the Executors therein named who took the oath of an executor prescribed by law and entered into and acknowledged their bond in the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars with Arthur Reid and Patrick Ryburn their securities conditioned as the law directs. A certificate is therefore granted them for the probate of the said Will in due form

Robert Stewart (1780 – 1832)

Biography

Robert Stewart was born in Lancaster Co, PA, and accompanied his parents down the Wilderness Trail to the Valley of the Holston, Washington Co, VA. He married Elizabeth Hussey in 1800 and their first five children were born there.

They left VA and traveled by horse and wagon through almost impassable wilderness, crossed the Ohio River during a flood with the river half mile in width at Limestone (now Mayberry) KY.

They arrived in Greene Co, OH, 11 Mar 1810 and settled about a mile southwest of Bowersville. Robert literally cut their farm out of the Ohio forrest and built a cabin of hewed logs. He volunteered for the War of 1812 and was detailed to guard duty a Urbana (just south of Springfield) OH where he served for 42 days.

They sold their property in OH on 28 Nov 1829 and migrated through IN to IL where they settled. In April 1832, they found themselves in the midst of the Black Hawk Indian War. Robert joined a group of volunteers and was killed in the summer of 1832, leaving his wife and 13 children (6 now adults). Elizabeth moved to Burlington, IA, with her sons in 1836.

Sgt Joseph Franklin Stewart (1818 – 1897)

Biography

My grandfather, Sgt. Joseph F. Stewart, is descended from one of three Stewart brothers who came to America in the 17th century from Edinburgh, Scotland. (my mother told me that for their safety that they came to America to get away from Queen Elizabeth Stewart of England, who had beheaded Mary Stewart of Scotland.) Grandpa married Rebecca Coffel². He was a Sgt. in Co. G., 46th Iowa Infantry in the Civil War. Grandpa came with his family to Ottawa County, KS, in a covered wagon from IA in 1880. My mother was only 9 at the time. They lived in a cave near the Crosson farm until they got their farm land. Mother said that while living in the cave, they saw Indians riding by, but they never bothered them. Grandpa bought the 80 acre farm from a Denver land company for \$1,000, located east and north of Minneapolis, KS. Grandpa was 62 when he came to KS to farm. He later bought a home at 416 N. Concord, Minneapolis.....by Jane Jackson Zeek

¹ I show a Robert Stewart marriage record from Blount County, Tennessee, to Elizabeth Hussey on 22 Dec 1800. Elizabeth was the daughter of Christopher and Mary Mickle Hussey. Elizabeth's third great-grandparents were Captain Christopher and Theodote Batchilier Hussey. Theodote's father, Reverend Stephen Batchilier, lived a colorful ninety-nine years, and was the forefather of a number of prominent public figures, including Richard Nixon, James Dean, and Daniel Webster.

² Rebecca Coffel Stewart died on 3 November 1889 in Ottawa County, Kansas. Joseph Franklin Stewart died on 19 June 1897 in Ottawa County - I still need to locate their grave sites. I found a death record in the county court house with mention of the death of J. F. Stewart.

Civil War Record Extracts (Joseph Franklin Stewart)

5 May 1864 - J. F. Stewart enlisted in Co. G 46 Iowa Infantry at Iconium, Iowa.

23 Sept 1864 – discharged from service at Davenport, Iowa.

21 Mar 1889 – statement by Josiah Kellogg of Monroe Co, Iowa described circumstance of J. F. Stewart’s disability. “the first I knew of his sickness was at the wharf at Memphis Tenn either the 17th or 18th of Sept 1864 about the time we were starting up the river on a boat for Davenport Iowa. He was suffering from sunstroke It was so sever that he had to be helped in getting on the boat not able to walk alone – continued in that disabled condition until he reached Davenport Iowa. He was taken to the hospital – remained there several days got better and was sent home. I was with him in the hospital until discharged.”

22 Mar 1890 – Statement provided by John Davis¹: “he personally and intimately acquainted with the claimant Joseph F. Stewart in Appanoose Co. Ia. From 1865 to 1873. That with exception of the year 1869 and 1871 he lived most of the time in the same home with claimant and when not living with him residing close by, that he saw claimant daily and worked for him at farming that most of the time during these years claimant was engaged in farming, that he was unable to do a very little work himself.” John goes on to describe J. F. Stewart’s ailments as a result of sunstroke he received while in the military.

26 May 1890 – Statements by William Davis²: “I saw claimant the day he got home I ?? the date by my youngest brother being born on that day.” William goes on to describe J. F. Stewart’s ailments as a result of his sunstroke.

5 May 1890 – Statement by O. J. Lambertson³: He first met J. F. Stewart when he came from Iowa to Kansas in fall of 1878. “Think claimant has never saw a well day since I have new him. He appeared to be week unfit for work. In fact never considered him to be fit for manuel labor at any time not with standing he has done work such as driving team work that any boy could of done. Being aquainted with his brothers in Iowa In comeing to this state went to see hom and formed his acquaintance and never severed our friendship I live in town and am in Grocery business and he trades with me more or less and I see him most frequently.”

21 Jan 1891 - Medical record states Joseph Stewart was 5’ 8 inches tall and 118 pounds. “soldier has no teeth and gums are so much atrophied false teeth cannot be worn”. Mention was made in one record that he was missing an arm (not battle related). All medical disability claims stemmed from a bout of sunstroke he received while in Memphis, Tennessee – prior to his discharge from service.

18 Feb 1896 – Declaration for Invalid Pension. “That he is to a material extent disqualified from earning a support by manual labor, by reason of loss of left arm, catarrh of head and eyes, rheumatism debility from age.

30 Mar 1898 – 6\$ per month pension claim dropped due to 24 Jun 1897 death of claimant.

¹ John Davis was son-in-law to J. F. Stewart (married to Elizabeth Louisa Stewart).

² William Davis was the sun of Edmund Davis and brother to John – he refer’s to George Davis who was born on Sept. 25, 1865.

Rebecca Stewart b. 1825 in OH, 12th of 13 ch. of Robt. and Eliz. (Hussey) Stewart. The family began in America during the American Revolution. Insight from a Stewart Descendant

I have a great interest in Rebecca Stewart¹. I think she was the toughest lady in the world. She lost her father in the Black [Hawk] Indian war when she was seven. She lost her husband in the Civil War. She went to St. Louis in a team and wagon, picked up John W. He died the next day & she took his body back to Des Moines Co. and buried him, then took the kids to Monroe Co. and raised them. She went to Kansas and raised Robert E. Bain's [her son] kids. His wife died. She lived in a dugout near Lamar, then built her a stone house.
